

As you know preparations are well under way for our **125 years celebrations on 24 and 25 Sept**. We would like to take the opportunity for anyone that would like to make a one off gift to the life and work of the church **in celebration of 125 years of Christian ministry to invest**

Please prayerfully start to consider what your response might be. We have also received a generous offer to match fund any donations made in this way up to the value of £20,000.
