

Do pray during the week for all our events at St Gabriel's, sharing the love in Cricklewood.

Here are some additional topics for prayer:

- Let's delight that God invites us to be in his presence in prayer sometimes in stillness, sometimes in silence. As you spend time with God, ask him to make himself known to you more and more.
- Thank God for seasons of the year. Pray for our Light Fest, sharing that Jesus is the Light of the World. Pray for children to bring their friends. Pray for Mariam and Susie in the planning and for enough helpers on the day.
- Pray about the unsettled political arena, both in this country and more widely. Pray for our next Prime
 Minister to be a someone who will lead parliament well, being mindful of all people, with justice and
 goodness. Pray too about an end to the war in Ukraine, and a way forward with lasting peace.
- Thank God for our Christians Against Poverty weekend, that more people are now aware of its work, and for the money given to continue funding the Debt Centre. Pray for God's leading for the future, if there are new ventures he is leading us to begin. Thank God for all the befrienders alongside clients, and pray for them in the friendship they give.
- Ask for God's comfort and healing for those you know who are in trouble or need of some kind. Pray for them to know God alongside them through everything. Thank God for a time when you have been aware of his company with you.
