
Evening Carols will be on a Saturday this year so as not to clash with the World Cup Final.

Do pray during the week for all our events at St Gabriel's, sharing the love in Cricklewood.

Here are some additional topics for prayer:

- Let's delight that God invites us to be in his presence in prayer ask him to lead you in how to pray for revival, for many more to believe the good news that Jesus' has bought forgiveness for all.
- Thank God for seasons of the year. Pray for our Light Fest. Pray for children who come to open their hearts to Jesus, the light of the world. If you're praying after the event itself, pray for families to go on chatting about what they were involved in, continuing to think about Jesus. Pray for whole families to come to faith in our community.
- Pray about the unsettled political arena, both in this country and more widely. Pray for parliament to make decisions that will bring about justice and goodness for more people.
- Ask for those in sadness, trouble or illness to know God is close and loves them. Pray for relief, joy
  and healing.
- Thank God for all those who run our regular activities, and pray for renewed enthusiasm and energy as groups meet again after half term. Thank God for the space we have in church for such a variety of events to take place, sharing God's love.
- Pray for an end to the war in Ukraine, and a way forward with lasting peace. Pray too for other parts of the world where you know there is conflict and injustice, and pray for peace, and for governments to work for a peaceful environment for all their people.
- Thank God for one thing every day!
