Prayer Points

Do pray during the week for St Gabriel's, sharing the love in Cricklewood.

Here are some topics for prayer you may like to include:

- Thank God for his presence with us through everything, for stories shared in Sunday services and in conversation, for how God builds our faith through each other.
- Pray for our 'Faith Works' Sunday series to encourage and help us to stand firm and stay faithful to God, in all circumstances in our life. Pray for someone you know who is struggling with living their faith in everyday life.
- Continue to pray for the deaf church in Turkey. Thank God for the enthusiasm and faith of the believers, and pray for ideas of sharing their faith to progress well and spread God's kingdom in the deaf community. Pray for spiritual protection from discouragements and from any direct opposition.
- Pray for Alpha. Thank God for those who have joined, as they explore Christian faith together. Ask for God's Spirit to guide their thoughts and discussions, both at Alpha and during the week.
- Pray for an end to all the current pay disputes and consequent strikes. Pray for justice, and fair pay for all, for wisdom in weighing up the consequences and making decisions.
- Ask God to be close to any you know who need encouragement or healing, peace or endurance. Pray for those going through hard times. Pray too for someone you know who is going through good times, and pray that they too will stay faithful to God.
